Moodle – Turnitin Tutorial

What is Moodle?

Moodle is a free open source learning platform designed to provide educators, administrators and learners with a **single robust, secure and integrated system** to create personalized learning environments.

The name "Moodle" is acronym for (modular object-oriented dynamic learning environment)

What is Turnitin?

Turnitin just finds text that matches other sources in the vast Turnitin databases (internet source + uploaded papers) and shows those matches. It is up to a human being (a teacher) to determine whether those text matches are a problem or not (are plagiarism or not).

What is Ritaj?


Ritaj is Birzeit University Academic and Administrative Portal, it is not a learning platform, the relationship or activities between instructors and students are focused on sending files, announcements and memos only.

What do we have from all above?

The above three systems form a very good and easy to use learning environment including a similarity or text matching facility for uploaded papers, researchs or seminars. Moodle and Turnitin works in scope of classes and assignments, so you have to create a class or a course and add students to that class or course, put an assignment for them and they have to upload their work

Since students already registered for a section or more on Ritaj, it is easy to send the course with all its registered students to Moodle without the need to do this manually in Moodle.

Workflow:



In the next section you will see how to create a trunitin assignment in moodle, and how student will upload their paper and how to check the similarity result.

Creating a Trunitin Assignment in Moodle

- 1- Login to Ritaj
- 2- From Courses menu or box click on the section that you want to send to Moodle.


